New IRS Charitable Contributions Ruling: Beginning on January 1, 2007, a new provision regarding **cash** contributions goes into effect. Taxpayers who previously claimed a charitable deduction for **estimated** cash offerings to churches will no longer be able to deduct their estimates. They must maintain a record of receipts, canceled checks, or credit card statements. As bookkeeper, I do record loose checks received, and they will appear on your 2006 contributions report. However, **loose** cash CANNOT be credited to any specific account (cash received in stewardship envelopes is recorded). If you wish to make cash contributions without stewardship envelopes, the staff will gladly provide written receipts if you bring it to the office or if you place it in an envelope with your name and address clearly indicated.

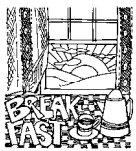

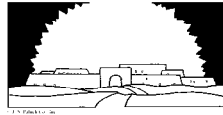
