LOVE ONE ANOTHER

In the Gospel for the Sixth Sunday of Easter we are met with an extraordinary challenge: Jesus commands us to “love one another as I love you” (John 15:12). The letter from John echoes this command. Of course, we are to love those in our family, those we work with, those we like. But the scriptures make clear that we are also to love those we never notice, those we purposely avoid, and even those we are tempted to despise.

In this Sunday’s selection from the Acts of the Apostles Peter shows us how far God’s love extends, and how far our love should extend in response. Peter realizes that God no longer “shows partiality” to the Jews, sharing divine love exclusively with them. Christ has revealed that God’s love extends to all people, and so should ours.

WHY BE REGISTERED IN THE PARISH?

When you attend Mass at the Shrine of St. Therese Church, you are a member of our Faith Community. However, it is very important that you formally register to officially become a member of the Parish Community, so that when you require documented information, you are more easily identifiable through the Parish records, e.g.,

- When needing a sponsor reference note.
- When needing a letter to confirm that you are a registered member of the Parish.
- To be eligible for Baptism or Marriage in the Parish.
- To receive Church Envelopes. When you contribute, it is important that you use the Church contribution envelopes. A record is then kept of your contributions which can be verified for tax purposes.
- To be notified of community events the Parish plans for you and your family.
- To inform you about Parish ministries so you can share your time and talent in areas that take advantage of your unique talents.

Registering helps us to serve you better. As an active parishioner, you have a right to ask for and expect help in times of need.

If you are registered and have a new address or phone, or are not registered and wish to register, please stop by or call the parish office to obtain the necessary form.
