## WEEKLY MIRACLE

This week marks the beginning of a kind of “liturgical detour.” We have been listening to Saint Mark’s Gospel during this liturgical year (Year B). Today we begin to hear a long section from John’s Gospel, starting with the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. This miracle story is a prelude to the Lord’s statements that we will begin hearing in a few weeks, where Jesus refers to himself as the “bread of life.” Each week we witness a miracle at Mass. We do not see a multiplication of loaves before us. What our eyes of faith allow us to see is the miracle of the transformation of common elements—bread and wine—into the Lord’s body and blood. Once we have received the Lord, the multiplication begins, for in the Eucharist we are strengthened to multiply our efforts to feed the poor, shelter the homeless, and bring comfort to the despairing. - © Copyright, J. ## MINISTERS AT THE ALTAR

A minister at the altar—server, lector, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion—is a public person representing the Church, and as such, should dress appropriately and modestly. T-shirts, jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, flip-flops and other beachwear are never appropriate apparel for serving at the altar. Women should wear either a dress of modest length and cut or slacks and a blouse. Men should wear at least a collared shirt (preferably with a tie), slacks and dress shoes. Servers should wear a collared shirt, dark pants and dark shoes. A minister dressed inappropriately will not serve.

If you cannot serve on a particular day or if you are going to be absent from a ministry, please call the parish office (542-1788) by noon on the Friday before. This courtesy allows us to plan ahead in your absence.

Please check in when you arrive to serve. Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion need to sign in on the board in the sacristy. Lectors need to pick up the book of petitions and the Lectionary from the sacristy. Servers need to dress. Give yourselves amply time before Mass so that you can prepare for and enter into the celebration of the Eucharist.
