Grocery Certificate Profits

During the first six months of 2010 (January through June) we sold \$67,428.24 in grocery certificates. At 5% profit this means the parish earned \$3,371.41. This was at no cost to the parishioners who use the certificates. It is an easy money-making project. We cannot earn 5% on any other investment right now.

Therefore, please continue to use the certificates or consider beginning to use them. This money goes to our building fund. Recently it was used for new air-conditioning units for the church. Insurance covered a portion of this cost; however, the bulk was paid from the building fund.

The parish uses these funds for various improvements. The parking lot paving is another example of its use.

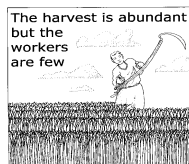
